

# UPHOLSTERY & FABRICS MOLD & MILDEW STAIN REMOVER (Item# TGC-MMR-32)

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Before using this product, eye protection and rubber gloves should be worn. Cover the ground under your work area before starting.
- 2. NOTE: Test for colourfastness in an inconspicuous area before using.
- 3. This product is ready to use.
- 4. Spray this liquid onto the fabric until the fabric is completely wet.
- 5. The time the remover needs to take effect depends on the extent of staining, and may vary from 3 to 10 minutes.
- 6. Remove dirt and grease with a soft scrubbing pad. Afterwards, rinse the treated fabric thoroughly with clean water and allow to dry.
- 7. If the stains have not been completely removed, the treatment can be repeated, leaving the remover a longer penetration time.
- 8. Afterwards use Fabric Protector to make the treated fabric water repellent again.
